### Live and help to live

Rameshbhai proposed Speed Dating to be shown as restricted funds. However, this is not possible and therefore our current policy will continue.

### 5) Secretary's Report

Living Organ Donation – Following the event in Hayes, a follow up session was held where a living donor coordinator was invited to provide further details on the next steps that would follow for those who are interested.

### 6) Vanik Professional Group

Discussions on resurrecting the Vanik Professional Group has taken place in previous meetings. However there has been no progress. Manharbhai gave a short summary on the background of the Vanik Professional Group for awareness to those who were not involved in the past.

In summary, the Vanik Professional Group was setup by NCVA(now Vanik Council) many years ago and was affiliated to NCVA(Vanik Council), however due to various reasons stopped operating. It was agreed that it would be useful resurrect this group with a defined set of aims and objectives. The aims and objectives however must consider the service it can provide to the community. The group also needs to be self-financing, following initial setup, costs using the budget that has been set aside.

Details of previous discussions on the purpose of this group are detailed below -

### Objective:

Main objective of the group is to provide tools, platform, help and assistance to professionals and Business persons of Vanik Community to create or/and enhance knowledge of the professions or businesses.

### How to achieve the Objective:

By organising seminars, talks and gathering for following matters.

- Health Awareness
- Financial Awareness
- Taxation Awareness
- Networking
- Business/professional support, guidance and mentoring
- Information Technology training
- Seminars and Mentoring for leadership and public speaking
- Political awareness/particiation and help in getting in politics and further progression
- Immigration and Visa Guidance

Dr Natubhai and Vijaybhai volunteered to be part of this committee and will discussed following the reelection.

### 7) Speed Dating

- A subcommitte meeting has been held to discuss the event scheduled in May. The registration

- Following discussion on the statistic of speed dating events, it was agreed that a summary should be published on our website. Rameshbhai to provide relevant information to Bhupenbhai. Continues.
- Chandrakantbhai asked for speed dating event flyers to be produced to help with the publicity. This was a good idea and will be carried out.

### 8) Matrimonial Register

132 members on the register of which there are 64 males and 68 females.

The current registration is manual, however will be electronic once our new website is up and running.

Following the last Speed Dating, it was agreed that those who registered for speed dating could also register for free to the matrimonial register.

The terms and conditions on the Matrimonial Registration forms have now been updated on the website.

For the future, we need to consider our strategy and enhancements to take the matrimonial register further. This may require several sub-committee meetings leading to scoping our future strategies.

### 9) Spiritual Care and Community Care

#### **Spiritual Care**

- Manharbhai gave a summary to those who attended of the service that Vanik Council is providing.
- The coordinator is Shashibhai Shah
- Hospice visits are under scrutiny. We are liaising with other chaplaincy such as Muslim and Christian and learning from their experiences. At present, we are considering visiting informally to learn and then decide on way forward. A small team has to be ready and prepared; outlining their function and duties before publication of leaflets.
- Funeral Services A number of individuals have shown interest. This includes individuals in Leicester and Manchester. Further discussions to be held with these individuals.
- Manharbhai has asked if attendees know of any volunteers who wish to be included. The demand for the funeral rites is high on the current individuals and therefore Manharbhai has requested more individuals to help with these services.

Live and help to live

- New initiatives are being discussed whereby Volunteers would be sent to help patients at their home, hospices, care homes, hospitals etc. Vanik Council is working with NHS and obtain a grant to provide this service. Over 25 volunteers have already shown an interest. The process(insurance, training etc) and determining the way forward is under discussions.
- Dr Natubhai indicated that grants are available to support patients at home if there are sufficient volunteers 'home champions'. This should be considered by the sub-committee.
- Chandrakantbhai mentioned that a ministry of loneliness has been formed. Vanik Council should investigate to determine if our community can be assisted.

### 10) New Project - Living Organ Donation

Vanik Council has been engaged on campaigning for organ donation; particularly donation of a kidney by living people. The project concentrates on live kidney transplants within the Jain community of North West London. It is funded by NHSBT.

Following invitation by NHSBT to submit a bid for further promotion within our community. A flyer has been produced for the next event due on 4<sup>th</sup> Mar 2018. All speakers have been confirmed and preparations are underway.

Many organisations have supported in promoting the flyer produced to their members. This is much appreciated.

Jain Network and Vanik Council are holding a Health and Wellbeing health seminar and organisations have been asked to promote this event.

### 11) E-Newsletter and Website

### Website

Vanik Directory - The developers have provided version of the migrated Vanik Database for test purposes. Feedback is being sought to ensure it works as expected.

Whilst the new website is being developed, Bhupenbhai has generated a website in the interim. All attendees were asked to visit the website and also send any information they wish to promote.

### E-Newsletter(Vanik Voice)

- All affiliated organisations were asked to provide details of events and articles for publication into the next issue of Vanik Voice.
- Suggestion has been received to collate an annual newsletter featuring main articles, events and activity of Vanik Council. It is suggested that report of all events should be sent soon afterwards to the editor for publication in Vanik Voice.
- Manharbhai has requested all affiliated organisations to send Vanik Voice to their ,members as soon as they receive a copy.

- Consideration should be given by Vanik Council to provide regular update all members, on a monthly basis, to include a summary of key events being promoted by individual organisations.
- Last directory was published in 2014. Discussions took place for re publishing this again. As soon as the new website is available, VC will start to promote this facility for families to begin updating their information. The intention will be to produce a copy soon after.
